CMSAA—Catholic Middle School Athletic Association Sponsors seasonal sport teams for 6th-8th grade students. Teams compete against other catholic schools in a variety of sports such as soccer, cross country, basketball, volleyball, baseball and others.

CLUBS— St. Martin's offers a variety of after school clubs.

Band: The Band Program is available to students in Grades 3-8, with or without experience. Half hour small group lessons are given after school on Wednesdays. The Band program is run by Paul Effman Music Service. The following instruments are available: flute, clarinet, trumpet, saxophone, trombone, bells, and drums.

Art Club: Students will be given the opportunity to explore art materials with emphasis on learning technique and self-expression. Children in Grades K-8 may participate.

Select Sports Program: Get up, get going and get active with Select Sports Program. A variety of sports each week such as soccer, basketball, dodgeball, capture the flag and kickball will be offered. Classes are offered for children in grades Pre-K-8th grade.

Recorder Club: Recorder Club is offered to children in grades 3-8 all year long. Children will be given the opportunity to perform in both winter and spring concerts.

Drama Club: Drama Club takes place after school for Grades 4-8. A production takes place in the late Spring for all members.

Dance Class: Dance offers a variety of classes for 2 year olds through 8th grade. Classes offered include: tap, ballet, hip hop, Irish step and Creative Movement. Dance classes are taught by Great South Bay Dance Company.
